Rules & Regulations

Camper's Age Requirement 15 - 35

April 26-28, 2019



1. Respect and obey FJA members, assistants, and camp staff.
2. Campers without registration or payment will not be accepted. Visitors or walk-ins who have not spoken to staff personnel will not be accepted, no exceptions. Application is nontransferable.
3. The use of jewelry such as rings, earrings, bracelets, chains, etc. is not allowed. Please be aware of the weather conditions. Bring modest clothing, appropriate for Sabbath.
4. Please use Christian vocabulary at all times. Refrain from profanity.
5. Please avoid distractions; do not bring PSP, IPODS, radios or other electronic devices. FJA and Camp Cedar Falls are not responsible for lost items or stolen property.
6. Damaging private property on CCF campgrounds including another camper's personal belonging, vehicles, etc. will remain as the sole responsibility of the camper.
7. Please be respectful to the noise level. Please be mindful and respect curfews.
8. Every camper should participate in the general programming; such as: meetings, meals and recreation.
9. It is strictly forbidden to visit the cabins/hotel rooms of the opposite sex.
10. Couples must maintain appropriate behavior; avoid being isolated from the group and away from the camp area.
11. Do not bring food into the rooms or cabins, remember we are in the middle of the mountains and there are animals that are attracted to this.
12. There will be no accommodations for married couples, with the exception of invited speakers and FJA personnel.
13. The participation of cleanliness and hygiene are required for each camper that resides within CCF campgrounds. Please be respectful and throw your trash away properly, including in the public restrooms, lodge, cabins, and shared space.
14. Firearms, knives, blades, explosives or flammable liquids, alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, the use or carry of recreational/medical marijuana, E-cigs, or any illegal substance are not allowed to be brought or used on CCF campgrounds (It is Private Property). The possession or use of these items are dealt with seriously, and if necessary will be reported to law officials.
15. Pets are not allowed.
16. Applications of minors that are not signed by their parents will be rejected. Applications not signed by the pastor will be rejected. Chaperones must indicate on the application, by checking the box, and must be approved by church Pastor.
17. No one will not be allowed to leave the camp before departure time without written permission by FJA staff.
18. The violation of one or more of the regulations may be grounds for dismissal from camp. Pastor and church board will be notified.
19. FJA has the authority to make changes to the above regulations.
20. Campers with any medical conditions are responsible for bringing their medication. FJA is not responsible for any medication forgotten by the camper. It is the camper's (parent's) assurance and responsibility of bringing medication.
